

Information about the processing of personal data through the CCTV system

1. Data Controller:

2. Purpose of processing and legal basis:

We use a surveillance system for the purpose of protecting persons and goods. The processing is necessary for legitimate interests pursued by the data controller (Article 6 (1) (f) of the GDPR).

3. Analysis of legitimate interests

Our legitimate interest is to protect our space and the goods within it from illegal acts, such as theft. The same applies to the safety of life, physical integrity, health, as well as the personal property of ourselves and third parties who are lawfully present in the monitored space. We only collect image data and limit the capture to areas where we have assessed that there is an increased likelihood of illegal acts being committed, such as at the entrances of the building of our company, at the welcome areas, at the storage room and production area, without focusing on areas where the privacy of individuals whose image is taken may be unduly restricted, including their right to respect for personal data.

4. Recipients

The stored material is accessible only by authorized personnel who are responsible for the security of the area. This material is not transmitted to third parties, except in the following cases: a) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial, and police authorities when it includes information necessary for the investigation of a criminal act involving the persons or goods of the data controller, b) to the competent judicial, prosecutorial, and police authorities when they lawfully request data in the exercise of their duties, and c) to the victim or perpetrator of a criminal act when the data may constitute evidence of the act.

5. Data retention period

We keep the data for up to fifteen (15) days, after which they are automatically deleted. If during this period we detect an incident, we isolate a section of the video and keep it for up to one (1) additional month, in order to investigate the incident and initiate legal proceedings to defend our legitimate interests. If the incident concerns a third party, we will keep the video for up to three (3) additional months.

6. Rights of data subjects

Data subjects have the following rights:

- Right of access: You have the right to know if we are processing your image and, if so, to receive a copy of it.
- Right of restriction: You have the right to ask us to restrict processing, such as not deleting data that you consider necessary to establish, exercise, or defend legal claims.
- Right to object: You have the right to object to processing.

· Right to erasure: You have the right to request that we erase your data. You can exercise your rights by sending it by email to the address: order@vriniotiswinery.gr, or by letter to our postal address, or by submitting the request in person at the store. To examine a request related to your image, you must specify approximately when you were within the range of the cameras and provide us with a photo of yourself, in order to facilitate the identification of your data and the hiding of third-party data. We also note that exercising the right to object or delete does not imply immediate deletion of data or changes in processing. In any case, we will respond to you in detail as soon as possible, within the deadlines set by GDPR.

7. Right to lodge a complaint

If you believe that the processing of your personal data violates the Regulation (EU) 2016/679, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority.
